LOCAL IMPACT MATTERS

Every child should feel accepted, supported, and celebrated in their identities. LGBTQ+ young people experience disproportionate harm as a result of their identities by their families, friends, classmates, and communities. It is easy to feel complacent because we are not facing the same legal challenges as folks in other states, our progress forward requires us to lead by example. Even here, LGBTQ+ youth continue to face isolation, discrimination, and violence. The 2021 MA Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS) demonstrates that LGBTQ+ youth are at higher risk for almost every type of bullying, harassment, health risks, and economic instability.

And for transgender and youth of color, these statistics can be higher with multiple identities layered on. As parents and community members, we must keep in mind that these statistics are products of the conditions in which our LGBTQ+ youth live. Decades of research show that disparities in rates of anxiety, depression and suicide ideation among LGBTQ+ students were nearly eliminated in communities with the most protective and inclusive schools. We have the power for change.

Our Impact

States across the country are increasing numbers of bans preventing teachers from educating students on LGBTQ+ issues, banning trans athletes from playing sports, criminalizing gender-affirming care for youth, limiting parenting rights, removing healthcare protections, and reversing overall discrimination protections. Individuals are harassing librarians and pushing for hundreds of books to be banned in communities everywhere. Right-wing extremist groups continue to spread mis/disinformation to spread false narratives and fear. Hospitals, including Boston Children's Hospital - are being targeted by anti-trans activists who picket entrances carrying signs and yelling hateful messages as families arrived for medical appointments with their children. Our children's worlds are getting smaller and scarier and the 2021 YRBS asks a new question about mental health and it shows a poor mental health status is strongly associated with LGBTQ identity.

Our work here matters and is critical to protecting our LGBTQ+ friends, family, and community members.

Healthcare and LGBTQ+ Youth

TRANS YOUTH AND FAMILY DAY—Two panels of doctors from top medical institutions in the Boston area provided information for parents and others about the range of healthcare options available for transgender youth, including information on mental health, ideas on how to recognize and support the youth in crisis, and medical assistance for people, such as puberty blockers and hormones.

TRANS DAY OF VISIBILITY—Organized in partnership with the Commonwealth's Commission on LGBTQ Youth, this event was held on the Massachusetts State House steps. Over 150 attendees and several legislators both attended and spoke at the event, including Senate President Karen Spilka and House Speaker Pro Tem Kate Hogan.

Schools and LGBTQ+ Youth

Greater Boston PFLAG's Safe Schools program directly addresses the challenges LGBTQ+ youth face by educating staff and students at area schools with over 70 engagements throughout the region.

Research demonstrates that the staff educational program has made schools a safer place for LGBTQ+ students by improving teachers' attitudes towards these students and increasing their comfort in intervening in anti-LGBTQ+ behaviors.

Communities and LGBTQ+ Youth

We have 18 support groups across Eastern Massachusetts: helping parents, caregivers, and community members better support their LGBTQ+ family members, friends, and community members.

GBPFLAG is partnering with the MA Department of Children and Families to improve the support available for LGBTQ+ kids in the foster care system, providing trainings, and resource guides to social workers and foster parents.

GBPFLAG is a member organization with dedicated seats on the Massachusetts Commission on LGBTQ Youth state agency to help advise others in state government on effective policies, programs, and resources for LGBTQ+youth.
